

Livestock Rules and Regulations- **Open Shows**

All animal entries must comply with 2021 Health Rules and Regulations set forth by Maryland Dept. of Agriculture. Health papers will be checked upon unloading of animals. Any one not having approved health papers (CVI and self-check form) will not be permitted to unload.

All 4-H/FFA livestock must be entered between 7am-4pm on Monday August 9, 2021. Open livestock entries see specific shows for entering times.

Purebred animals must have breed association registration papers issued in the name of the exhibitor. Commercial breeding animals must have appropriate 4-H tag & copies of livestock registration paperwork. 4-H/FFA breeding animals must be owned by July 1, 2021. Anyone not having registration papers will not be permitted to show. Exhibitors must have continuous ownership of their animals from July 1, 2021 to show day.

All displays and farm signs must be kept at or in your individual stall area. No commercial or advertising signs are allowed at the fair unless you have a booth at the fair.

Animals are not permitted to leave the grounds at all unless the fair chairman or the veterinarian approves. If caught, you will not be allowed back the following year. All stalls must be cleaned before leaving the fairground or premiums will be withheld! Do not leave bedding in the middle of the barns. It must be removed from barns and put in the manure dumping area.
